Sing songs as you go, and hold close together.
You may at times grow confused and lose your way.
Continue to call each other by the names I've given you, to help remember who you are.
You will get where you are going by remembering who you are.
Touch each other and keep telling the stories.

Make maps as you go remembering the way back from before you were born.

So you will be only the first of many waves of deliverance on these desert seas. It is the first of many beginnings your Paschaltide.

Remain true to this mystery.
