Throughout the summer months, the Call Committee has been working through the process of interviewing candidates for a pastor/deacon in the area of Children's, Youth and Family ministries.

In early August, the Call Committee unanimously voted to extend a Letter of Call to Victoria (Tori) Remer to serve as Pastor of Youth and Young Adult Engagement. Her areas of ministry will include: confirmation ministries as well as ministries for our youth and young adults.
