## TAKING IT HOME

We talked about what a promise is, and how God promises to love us always! God promised Abram that he would have a big family—more than all the stars in the sky! God promised to care for Abram, and he cares for us too!

**IN THE CAR:** Look out the window— tell me what you see? Can you count the \_\_\_ (cars, trees, etc)? God loves you more than all of those!

**BEDTIME:** You learned that God promises to love you always! When God told Abram to look in the sky and count the stars— there were a lot of stars! (if you can look out a window and see stars, do it). God told Abram that he would have a BIG family, as big as all the stars! I am so happy you are in our family! I promise to love you always too! When we make a promise, it means that we will do what we say— God loves you always, and I (we) love you always too! Isn't that wonderful?

**Pray:** Dear God, Thank you for loving us all the time! Thank you for hearing us, for loving us and always being with us no matter where we go. Thank you for keeping your promises!

**Pray:** Dear God, Thank you for the stars! Thank you for our family! Thank you for promising to love us always and for keeping your promises!
