1. Call to Order

10. Stewardship/Celebration Weekend

Pastor Craig reported on the Celebration weekend plan for November 12 and 13th. There will be two services, 5 PM on Saturday and 10 AM on Sunday. A pork dinner will follow each service.

11. Other Business

It was reported that the new website will be operational on Friday, October 21. It is very user friendly and a work in progress. Suggestions are always welcome!
