Council Meeting Minutes May 15, 2014 (Next mtgs: June 12, Aug 21)

Immediate Maintenance Issues -- Dave Booms and Steve Henry

Recommended forming "Risk Management Committee" with expertise in insurance, ADA, safety, security, etc., maybe meet quarterly. Council asked Dave/Steve to draft charter.

List of maintenance issues (these total \$172,000) -- Steve

(Note: Building Fund is primarily used for mortgage, property tax)

- 1. Patch parking lots: \$40,000. Patch 16,000 sq ft (grind out and refill), locations in both lots (1/4 size of south lot). Will last for about 5 years. Replace entire north side lot alone is \$70,000, but good for ~20 yrs
- 2. Sidewalks: \$10,000 east side by pre-school, outside office entrance
- 3. Roof Replacement on '55 building: \$10,000
- 4. Replace door/frame on preschool entrance to bring in line with other security upgrades (keyless entry, etc): \$5000
- 5. Window replacements on north side of '55 building: \$8000. Holes in frames due to rot. Have been called by city of Roseville
- 6. Minor roof patching for '65 building and commons: \$2000
- 7. Tree removal in green space: \$1000.
- Door replacement on HVAC enclosure on east side of worship center—security issue. \$5000 for roll-down steel door
- 9. Worship center shades-replace all 12: \$5000
- 10. Design of worship center roof—no overhang, and water comes down bricks (causes deterioration), can get ice blocking fire exits from worship center. To modify\$30,000
- 11. Carpet replacement: for Commons (8000 sq ft)-- \$40,000;
- 12. Carpet replacement: Great Hall--\$9000
- 13. Bus: can lease a new bus for \$7000 / yr over 5 yrs. 12,000 miles/yr

Council asked for document prioritizing list and tabulating cost estimates.

Kitchen (Dave relayed info from Connie). Kitchen fund is at about \$209,000.

Immediate

- 1. Freezer has failed (\$4600)—already purchased
- 2. Dishwasher (~50 yrs old). Can't just replace, because code no longer allows corner units or having dishwasher in same room as food prep. Recommend rental unit (\$209/month, requires dedicated water heater) so that don't have to retrofit if large remodel occurs. Probably locate in old family bathroom (~140 sq ft), remodel room for about \$14,000, plumbing re-fit could add more costs.

1-5 yrs Out

1. Double convection oven \$7000

6-10 yrs Out

1. Stove - \$5400

Motion made and secondedto allow Connie+staff to spend up to \$25K to replace dishwasher (e.g. lease new unit, new water heater, room remodel and plumbing costs).

Staff Updates

Cake/recognition for departing staff (Pete and Judine)

Michael Jordan will become director of high school ministry.

Half time position for 5-8th: most likely intern from Luther Seminary. Applications due in summer.

Endowment Committe Updates - Janine

Endowment Cmte got 6 requests. Mission and Outreach (\$2000); Communications (\$1950); Univ of MN –chapel at hospital (asked for \$2000, approved \$1000); Hospitality – conference cloths (\$2000); Banyan Community summer youth program (\$2000 for sponsoring 4 children); Design team – bookcases (\$2000, declined for now)

Motion made and seconded to approve these grant requests. Passed unanimously.

Change charter for designated/restricted funds; currently set at \$50,000; asking to be changed to \$25,000.

Motion made and seconded to approve change in charter for Endowment Committee to reduce minimum amount for restricted fund donation to \$25,000. Passed unanimously.

Finance Update - Kris

Easter + Lent similar to 2013

Giving slightly down, again giving units down.

Expenses for Apr were above plan, but in line with 2013; the expense budget for Apr seemed unrealistically low. Total expenses still behind budgeted amount for year, but giving is substantially behind (-\$72K), so result is that now behind plan by \$29K.

Currently dedicated funds at ~\$400K; but borrowed ~\$120K against that to cover earlier shortfall, and that has not yet been repaid.

Stewardship Discussion

Stewardship Committee – Greg Johnson will be chair. Will start recruiting members, planning to meet over summer. Pastor Steve will call Greg.

Stewardship Survey – Steve asked council to read narrative comments, discuss at June council meeting.

Ministry Team Updates
