Camp Hiawatha 2021

June 27 - July 2

Sunday, June 27

- **This year we WILL NOT be taking a bus to camp due to Covid.**
 - Parents will be expected to drop their kids off at camp AND pick them up on Friday.
 - Before leaving the Twin Cities, you will need to stop at RLC (the Ryan Ave lot) to have your Pre-Camp Health Screening form checked by either Abby or Audrey.
 - Students should arrive at camp between 2 and 4:30 p.m. *As we get closer to the departure date these times may change to allow for staggered drop off by grade.*
 - At camp, registration will be done in a drive through style with outdoor stations Families will be asked to stay in their vehicles. Campers can exit after completing the registration process.
 - Youth will be led by a counselor and split into same gender cabins of ~ 4 youth
- *Cabins at Camp Hiawatha are bunked with private bathroom and shower*
