## RLC Kids

We want to offer a safe and faith filled experience for kids and their families on Sunday mornings. In response to parent feedback, this year we are changing the schedule for **RLC Kids** (formerly Cornerstone).

RLC Kids will begin September 19. We are offering parents two different worship options at 9:00 or 10:30. RLC Kids will be held during Worship. Online registration begins August 1st.

### RLC KIDS SUNDAY SCHEDULE

- Parents will check in their kids using the kiosks in the Lobby or in the Commons when they enter church for Worship.
- Preschoolers (age 3 by Sept. 1) - kindergarten. Parents will bring their children to Room 45A at either 9 or 10:30. Children will stay there for the whole hour.
- 1st-6th graders will start the morning in Worship with their family and leave for RLC Kids after Storytime. They will follow a leader to their Large Group space to dig into the message a little deeper through music, their Bibles, activities and games.
- 1st-6th graders will rejoin their family in Worship toward the end of the service to experience Communion, Baptisms and closing prayers and music.

This schedule will allow kids to experience Worship and also give them the opportunity to reinforce the day's message given in a fun and engaging way.

**WHAT'S NOT CHANGING?** Special Serve Sundays will still be a part of RLC Kids to offer a way to serve our neighbors. On Serve Sundays there will not be RLC Kids regular programming.

**SOMETHING NEW!** Lunch Bunch will be offered periodically from 11:30-1:00. Kids bring a sack lunch and stay at church to eat together and enjoy new friends with games and activities. This will give parents an opportunity to gather together for a coffee, run errands or have a little down time.
